

Earl Lhamon, Professor Emeritus Ohio Northern University, will speak at UU Lima Sunday March 4, 2012. He studied Physics, Electrical Engineering and Mathematics at ONU, BG and Univ of Toledo. Prof. Lhamon taught Mathematics (primarily to Engineering and Pharmacy students) for 42 years at ONU, then Physics and Astronomy at OSU-Lima for one year. He notes that "Before retiring I counted over 9600 names in my grade books". His wife Joyce taught for 30 years. They have three children: Shondra Grammens (Comp Sci ONU), Mike Lhamon (PhD Electrical Engineering & MBA ONU, Georgia Tech Ga , Univ Ky), and Margie Reams (Biology Univ Richmond VA and MD/PhD in Neurology at Duke). Astronomy has been a hobby since his college days and he was president of the Lima Astronomical Society when the Schoonover Observatory was build in 1963.

The power point talk is titled "Astronomy and the Bible." Concepts in Astronomy will be presented to illustrated the significance of Job 38:31-38 (KJV). These passages are consistent with 20th Century Astronomy.
